**Music links** – Tudor music and dance

**Stand alone Music** – Samba – Somerset Music – Year 4

**Science Links** – Electricity/light - Investigate circuits, symbols, sources of power. Link to Theatre- Create a circuit for a spot light.

**Art** – portraits – Holbein – To analyse and discuss features of Holbein’s work and create portraits in a similar style in a range of mediums.

**Design and Technology links** – Tudor Theatres – Children research, design and make and evaluate a Tudor theatre using shoe boxes. Children use scripts created in Literacy to produce a ‘Shoe box Show’
