**Concern has been raised by staff, parents and residents at St. John the Evangelist CEVA Primary School about parking outside school.**

Please remember the Highway Code when dropping off or collecting from school.

You must not park where there are restrictions shown by:

- Yellow lines along the edge of the carriageway
- School entrance markings on the carriageway

Do not park your vehicle where it would endanger, inconvenience or obstruct pedestrians or other road users.

For example:-

**Do Not Stop**

- near a school entrance
- anywhere you would prevent access for Emergency Services Vehicles
- at or near a bus stop or taxi rank
- opposite or within 10m of a junction, except in an authorised parking space
- where the kerb has been lowered to help wheelchair users
- in front of an entrance to a property
- on a bend
- partially or wholly on a pavement

Remember it is safer for your passengers (especially children) to get out of the vehicle on the side next to the kerb.

Clevedon Police would like to remind you that it is an offence to park on Zig Zag lines outside the school, the penalty for parking on these lines is £50 and will be enforced by local officers.

The lines are in place for the safety of both you and your children.

When parking in the vicinity of the school can you please ensure you park safely, legally and with consideration for local residents, emergency vehicles which may need to pass and pedestrians.
