The Year 6 children will undertake their SATs tests between Monday 14th May and Thursday 17th May 2018.

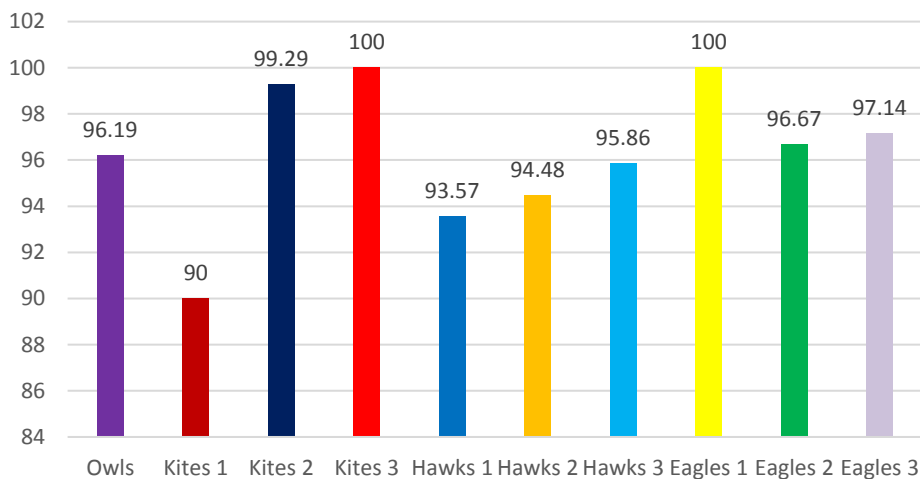
Please ensure your children attend school on these days and arrive on time.

Please remember that the school will be closed on Monday 7th May 2018 for the May Bank Holiday.

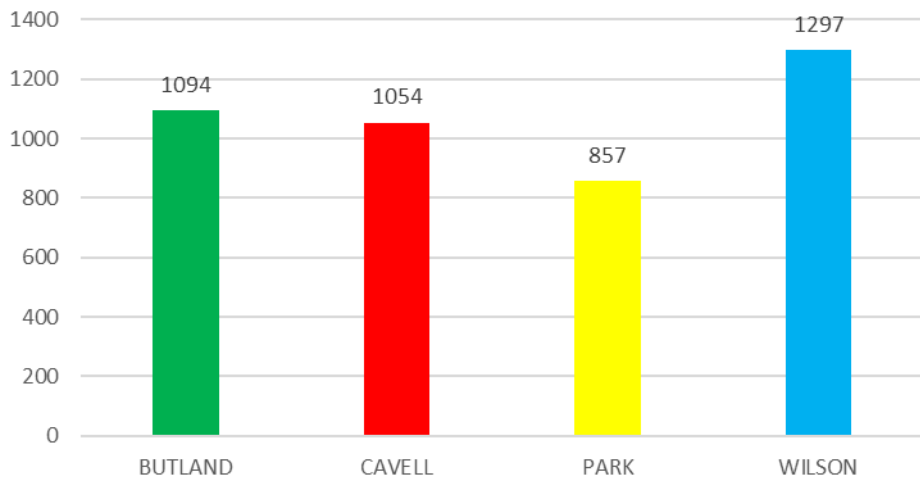
Attendance 23/04/18 to 27/04/18
