One Year 6 child said, "It was very fun and the costumes were great!"

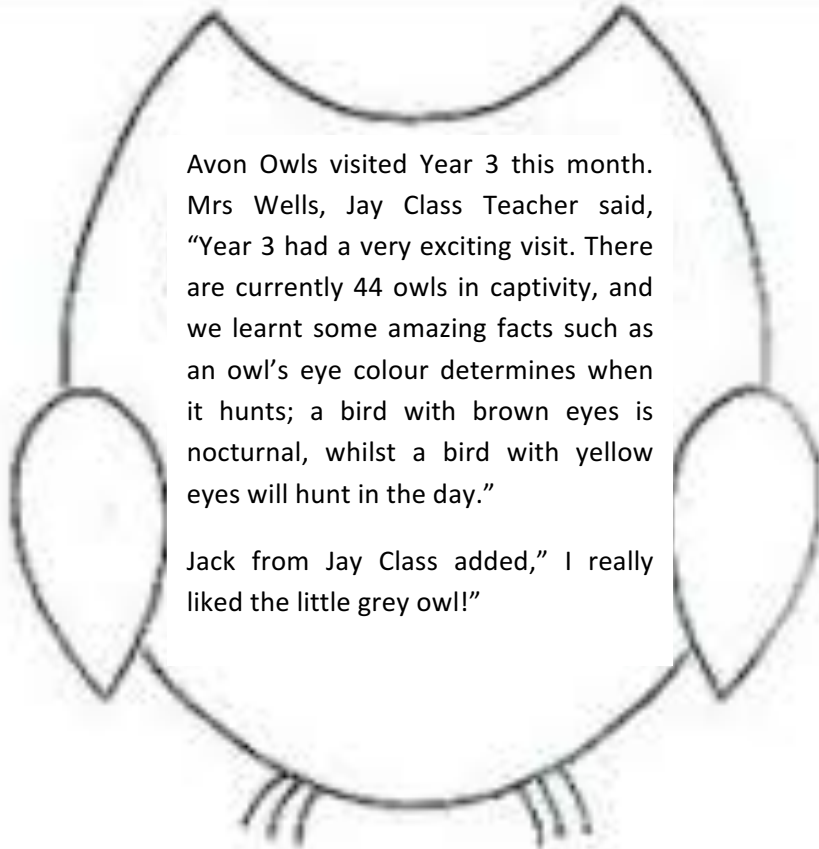
